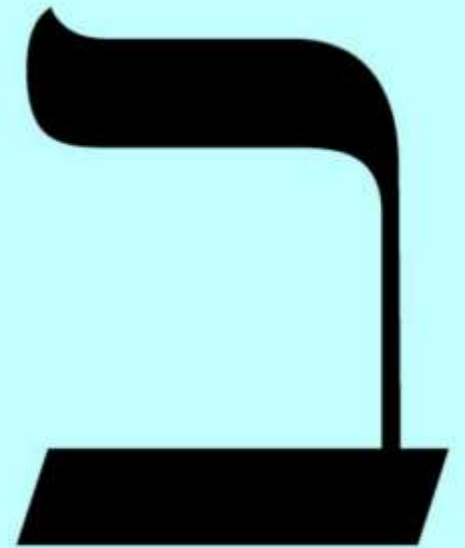

- We must have purity of heart
(Matthew 5:8) 2 Kings 23:25
- We must not have divided
affections - Matthew 6:19-24
- Our priorities must be His
priorities - Matthew 6:33
- We must give ourselves
wholly to God!
2 Corinthians 8:1-5
