- Those who are lost like the coin - Vs. 8
- Those who are lost like the prodigal son - Vs. 12
- Those who are lost like the elder son - Vs. 31



WAYS MEN ARE LOST

- Those who get lost like the sheep – Vs. 4
- Some are lost like the coin – Vs. 8
- Some are lost through sheer determination to disobey – Vs. 13, 29
