# Summary of the First Four Trumpets (Chapter Eight)

**The Trumpets represent the *announcement of coming judgments***

**(Revelation 6:11; 7:1-3; 9:13-14; 10:6)**

- **1<sup>st</sup> Trumpet - Hail and Fire**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Trumpet - Huge Fiery Mountain**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Trumpet - Great Star Wormwood**
- **4<sup>th</sup> Trumpet - 1/3 of Sun, Moon, Stars are Darkened**



# The “Little Apocalypse” (Matthew 24:4-8)

- **Take heed that no one deceives you**
- **For all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.**
- **All these are the beginning of sorrows**

“And Jesus answered and said to them: **Take heed that no one deceives you.** (5) For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. (6) And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; **for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.** (7) For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. (8) **All these are the beginning of sorrows.**”

# The “Abomination of Desolation”



**Mat 24:15-22 NKJV** "Therefore when you see the 'ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), (16) "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. (17) Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. (18) And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. (19) But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! (20) And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. (21) For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. (22) And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

# The Fifth Trumpet (Chapter Nine)

- **A star that had fallen from the sky to the earth - vs. 1**
- **Given Key and opened the Abyss - vs. 2**
- **Out of the Smoke locusts - vs. 3**
- **Harm only people who did not have the Seal of God on their foreheads - vs. 4-5**
- **May refer to the Zealots who poured into Jerusalem before the Siege of Cestius Gallus**
- **First Woe is Past -vs. 12**



# The Sixth Trumpet (Chapter Nine)

- **Voice coming from the four horns of the altar - vs. 13 (cf. Rev. 6:9-11)**
- **Release the four angels who had been kept for the day... (Rev. 7:1)**
- **Released to kill a third of mankind - vs. 15**
- **The number of the troops - vs. 16**
- **Description of the troops - vs. 17**
- **May refer to the campaign of Cestius Gallus**
- **The rest of mankind did not repent - vs. 20-21**


# Another Mighty Angel

- **Coming Down from Heaven**
- **Robed in a Cloud - Psa. 104:1-3**
- **Rainbow above His Head - (Rev. 4:3) Ezek. 1:27-28**
- **Face like the Sun (Rev 1:16) Ezek. 1:4; Matt. 7:12**
- **Legs like Fiery Pillars**
- ***Holding a Little Scroll***
- **Right Foot on the Sea (Gentiles)**
- **Left Foot on the Land (Israel)**
- **Gave a Loud Shout like the Roar of a Lion (Rev 5:5)**
- **Cf: Ezekiel 1:25-28; Revelation 1:14-16**





- **“When the Mighty Angel Shouted**
- **“The Voice of the Seven Thunders Spoke (Psalm 29)**
- **“I was About to Write...**
- **“I Heard a Voice from Heaven...**
- **“Seal up what the seven thunders have said and do not write it down.” (Deut. 29:29)**
- **Cf. Rev. 10:11; Daniel 12:4; Rev 22:10**

# Another Mighty Angel

- **Raised His Hand to Heaven - vs. 5**
- **Swore by Him Who Lives for ever and ever;**
  - *who created the heavens and all that is in them,*
  - *the earth and all that is in it,*
  - *the sea and all that is in it*



# “There Will Be No More Delay!”

- “In the days when the seventh angel is about to sound his trumpet - vs. 7
- “The mystery of God will be accomplished - vs. 7
- “Just as He announced to His servants the prophets.”



# “The Little Scroll”

- **“Take the Scroll - vs. 8-9**
- **“Eat it - vs. 9-10**
- **“It will turn your stomach sour  
- vs. 9**
- **“In your mouth it will be as sweet  
as honey - vs. 9 (cf: Ezek. 3:3, 14)**
- ***“You must prophesy again about  
many peoples, nations, languages  
and kings.” - vs. 11***



# Lessons to Learn

- **God hears the prayers of His servants - Rev. 6:9-11**
- **God answers the prayer of His servants - Rev. 9:13; 10:5-7**
- **God is just to avenge His servants (2 Thess. 1:3-10)**
