in the word to Your servant’*

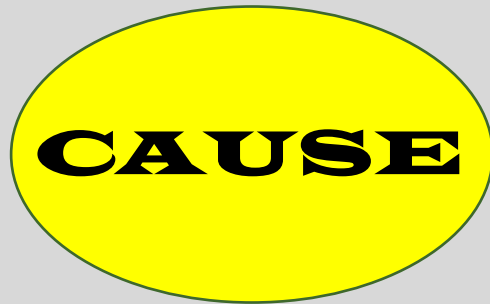
- God is faithful! – 1 Cor. 1:9; 10:13; 2 Cor. 1:18
