



Hebrews 11:5-22 (NKJV)

(5) And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "MY SON, DO NOT DESPISE THE CHASTENING OF THE LORD, NOR BE DISCOURAGED WHEN YOU ARE REBUKED BY HIM; (6) FOR WHOM THE LORD LOVES HE CHASTENS, AND SCOURGES EVERY SON WHOM HE RECEIVES." (7) If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? (8) But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. (9) Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? (10) For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness. (11) Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.




The Sequence of Judges

- Manoah's wife gave birth to Samson (13:24)
- The LORD strengthened and moved Samson (13:25)

- Samson saw a
 PHILISTINE woman in
 Timnah 14:1
 - This was the LORD's doing
 - **He** was looking for an opportunity
- He betrothed her for marriage – 14:4,5
- The roaring lion 14:5
- The wedding riddle –
 14:12
 - "Trick your husband 14:15*
 - If you had not plowed with my **HEIFER**...
 - The LORD empowered him.
 - He killed 30 men





SAMSON'S BATTLES WITH THE PHILISTINES

- Samson went down to visit his wife – 15:1
 - Her father had given her to his best man – 15:2
 - Enraged Samson
 BURNED their fields
 - The Philistines killed his wife and father-in-law
- The Philistines invaded Judah – 15:9-10
 - Judah hands Samson to the Philistines
 - He kills 1,000 men with the jaw of a donkey.









 The Philistines this OPPORTUNITY to try to capture Samson. – 16:2









SAMSON AND DELILAH

- Samson and the Prostitute 16:1
 - The Philistines this OPPORTUNITY to try to capture Samson. – 16:2
- Samson fell in love with Delilah
 - "Trick him! Find out what makes him... 16:5
 - Delilah was not Samson's wife
 - "Tell me what makes you strong*
 - "Finally, he told her his **SECRET**
 - She began to torment him
- The Philistines
 - Captured Samson
 - Put out his eyes
 - Bound him in bronze chains
 - He became a grinder in their prison
- His hair began to GROW back

Delilah Pestered Samson

(15) A continual dripping on a very rainy day And a contentious woman are alike; (16) Whoever restrains her restrains the wind, And grasps oil with his right hand.

(Proverbs 27:15-16 NKJV)

Until His Soul Was Vexed to Death

Better to dwell in a corner of a housetop, Than in a house shared with a contentious woman.

SAMSON'S TRAGIC DEATH

- The rulers of the Philistines gathered
 - Our god has handed Samson over
 - "Call for Samson so he can entertain us!"
- Position me so I can touch the PILLARS
 - Let me die with the Philistines
 - The temple collapsed on the rulers and all the people who were in it.
- His brothers and all his family went down and brought him back.
