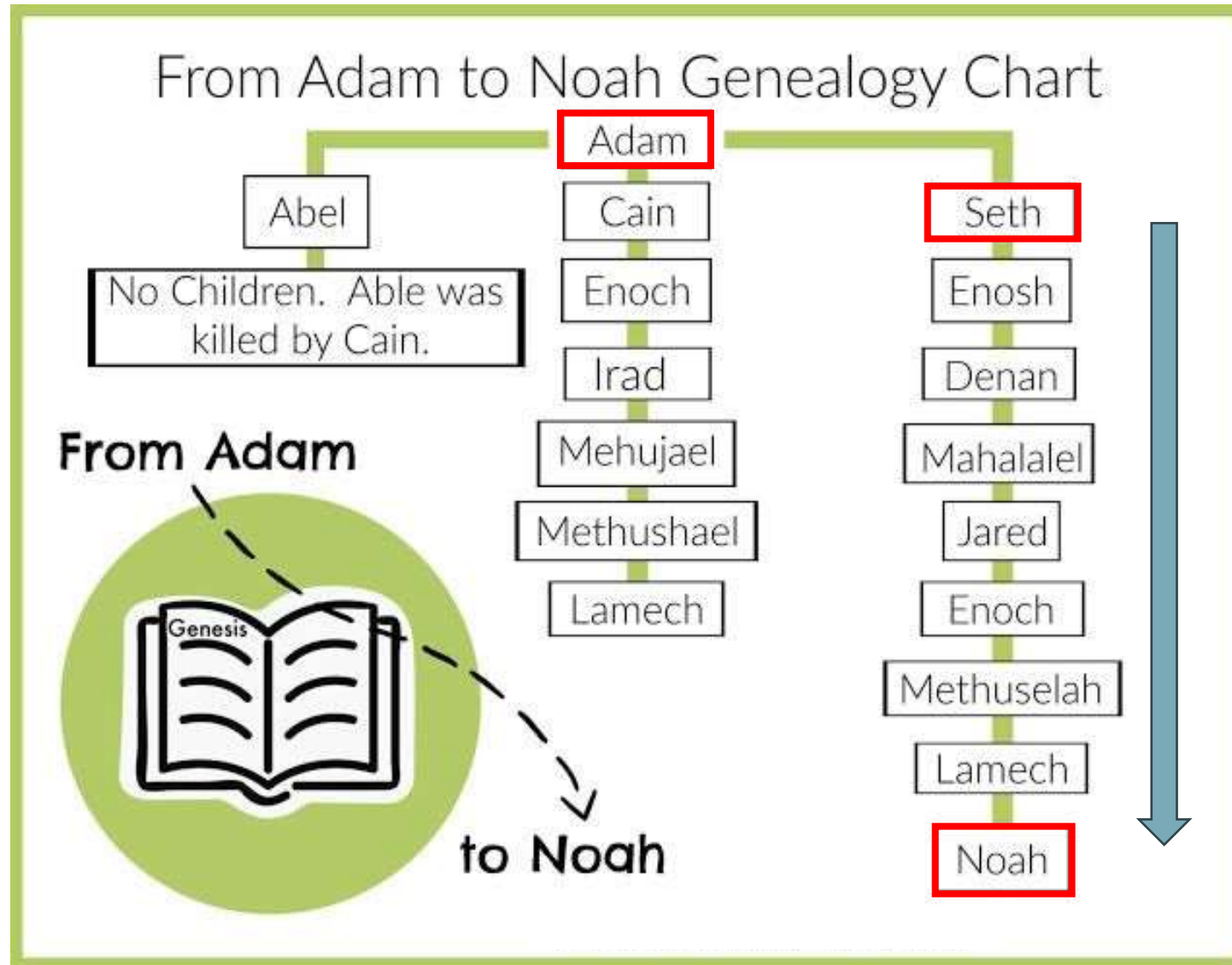

NOTE:

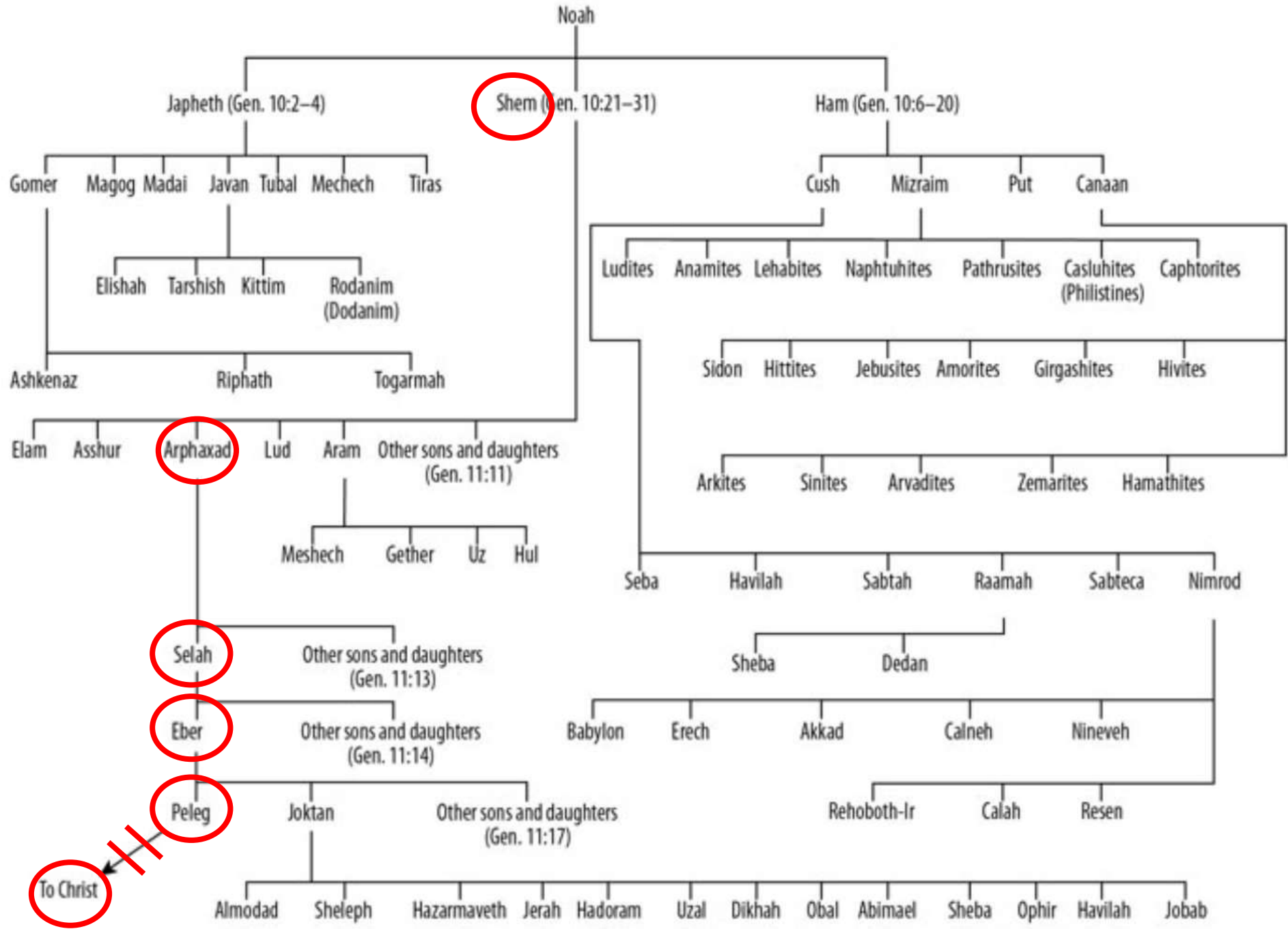
The are numerous issues with Biblical genealogy.

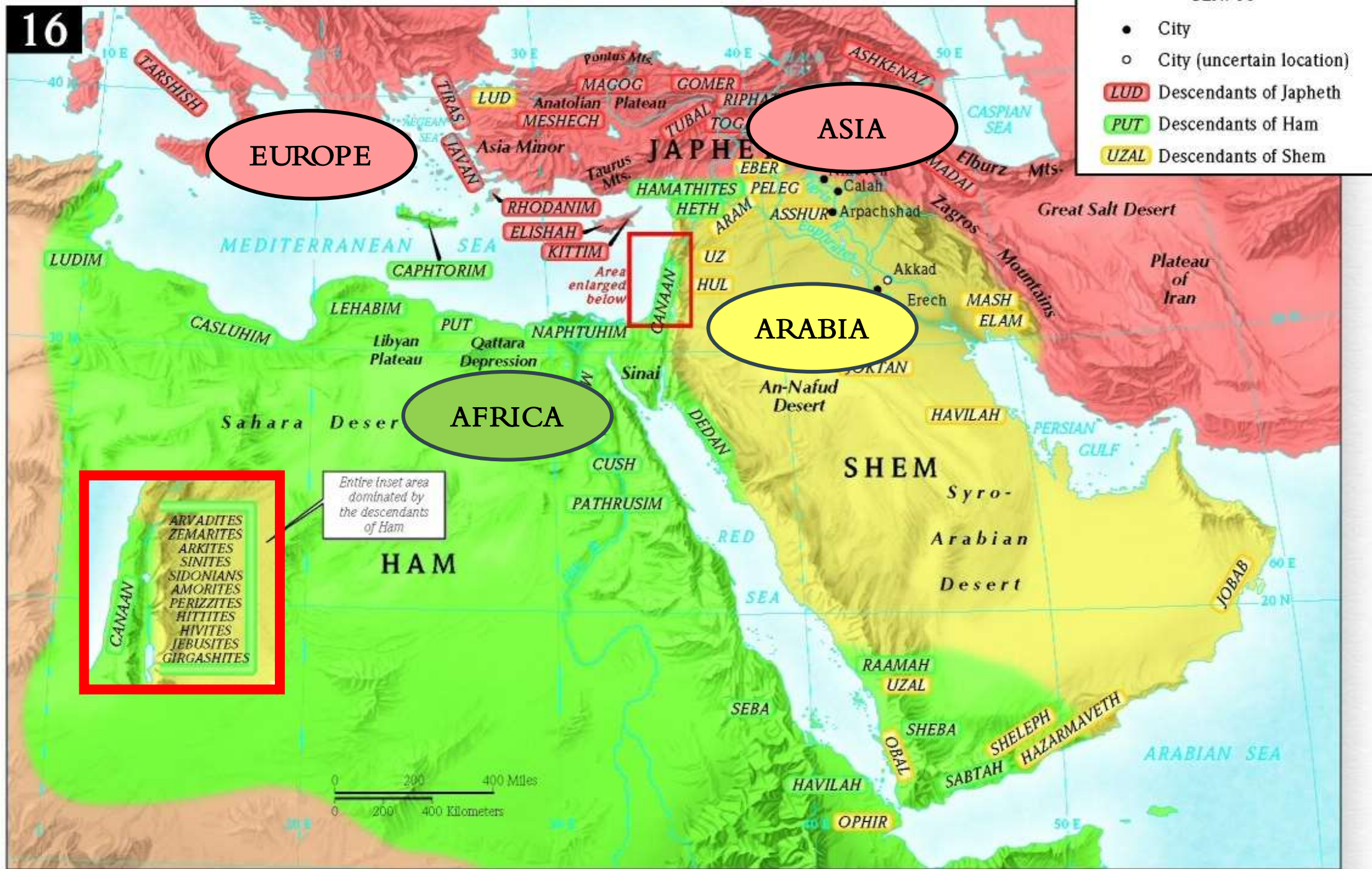
We can confidently infer they were not meant to give a person-by-person record Adam's descendants.

## THE COVENANT WITH ABRAM (GENESIS 15)

- God spoke to Abram in a vision (vs. 1, 7)
- Abraham asked for a sign, a child (vs. 2-3)
- God promised Abram a son (vs. 5)
- God called Abram from *Ur of Chaldeans* (vs. 7)
- God promised the land of Canaan to Abram's descendants (vs. 18-21)
- **Note verse sixteen**

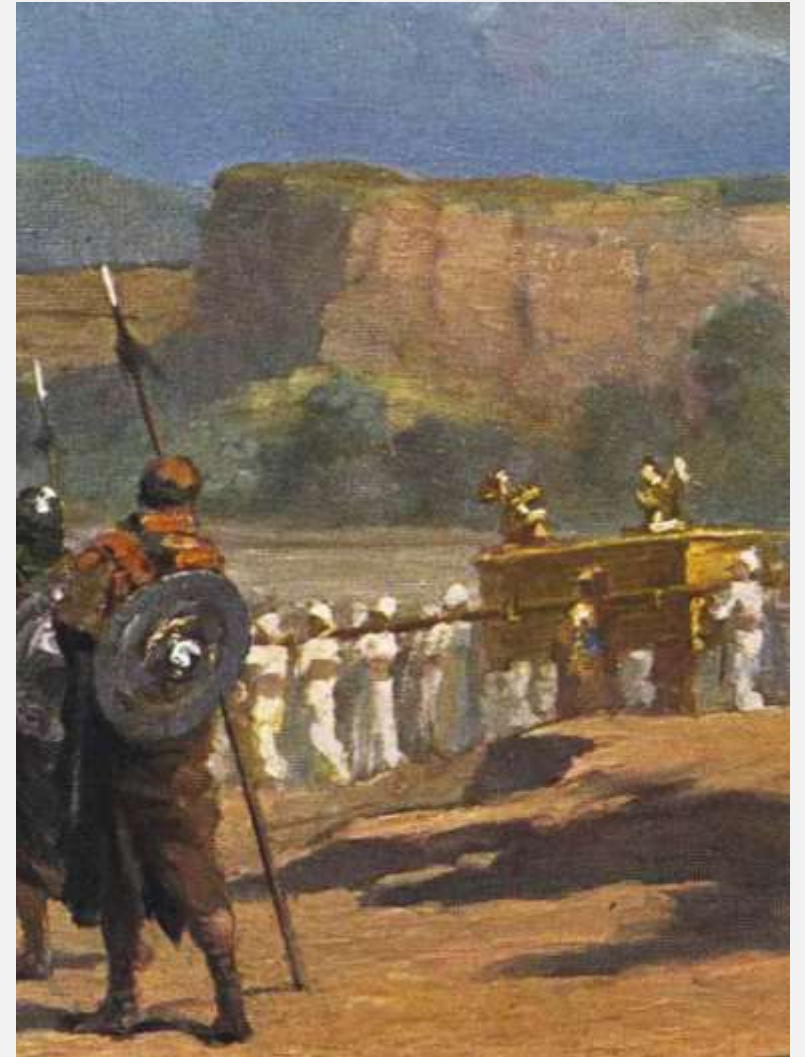


## NATIVE INHABITANTS ARE CAST OUT (EXODUS 3)

- God calls Moses to free Israel (vs. 1-5)
- He promises to fulfill His promise to Abram (vs. 6-10)
- He specifies the land of Canaan, including the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, and Jebusites.
- These were descendants of Ham
- God dispossessed them because of their idolatry and immorality - Leviticus 18:24-30

# ISRAEL FAILED TO DISPLACE

- God would help drive out the inhabitants of Canaan – Exodus 23:28-31
- Israel failed to displace the people of Palestine – Joshua 15:63; 16:10; 17:12-13; 23:5
- God left some as a snare for infidelity – Joshua 23:13



# ISRAEL VIOLATED THE MOSAIC COVENANT

Israel was cast out for disobeying the covenant – 2 Kings 17:7-23

Judah was also cast out for disobeying the covenant – Ezekiel 22:2-16

However, God promised to restore them to the land – Isaiah 11:11; Jeremiah 23:1-3







## THE REMNANT OF ISRAEL SAVED

- Following their restoration, the Jews rejected idolatry, but continued in wickedness.
- The people rejected Christ and sealed the fate of Israel. – **Romans 10:1-4**
- Although a remnant was preserved to fulfill the promise – **Romans 11:1-5**
- The old covenant was annulled, and the New Covenant was inaugurated. – **Hebrews 7:18-19; Colossians 2:13-15; Hebrews 10:8-10**

- Israel were once God's chosen people – Deuteronomy 7:6; 14:2
- Today, God's chosen people are His church – Acts 2:38-39, 47; 1 Peter 2:1-10; Acts 2



# WHO OWNS IT TODAY?

- The same One who always owned it  
**Psalm 24:1-2**
- The One who is sovereign – **Daniel 4:24-27**
- The One who gives, the One who takes away  
(Job 1:21)
- He has Committed All Authority to Jesus  
(Matthew 28:19-20)
- The land of Israel falls under the general rule  
of government – **Romans 13:1-7**



# WHAT ABOUT TODAY?

- Following World War 2, Israel came under the jurisdiction of Britain
- Britain awarded it to the Jewish people for their assistance
- Israel has legal possession of the land since 1947
- Hamas and Hezbollah are indigenous Palestinian groups, supported by Iran who seek to exile and exterminate the Jews once again.
- We (Christians or the United States) have no Biblical obligation to the nation of Israel except to preach the Gospel.
- However politically, they are the only democracy in the Middle East, and have been a loyal ally.
