

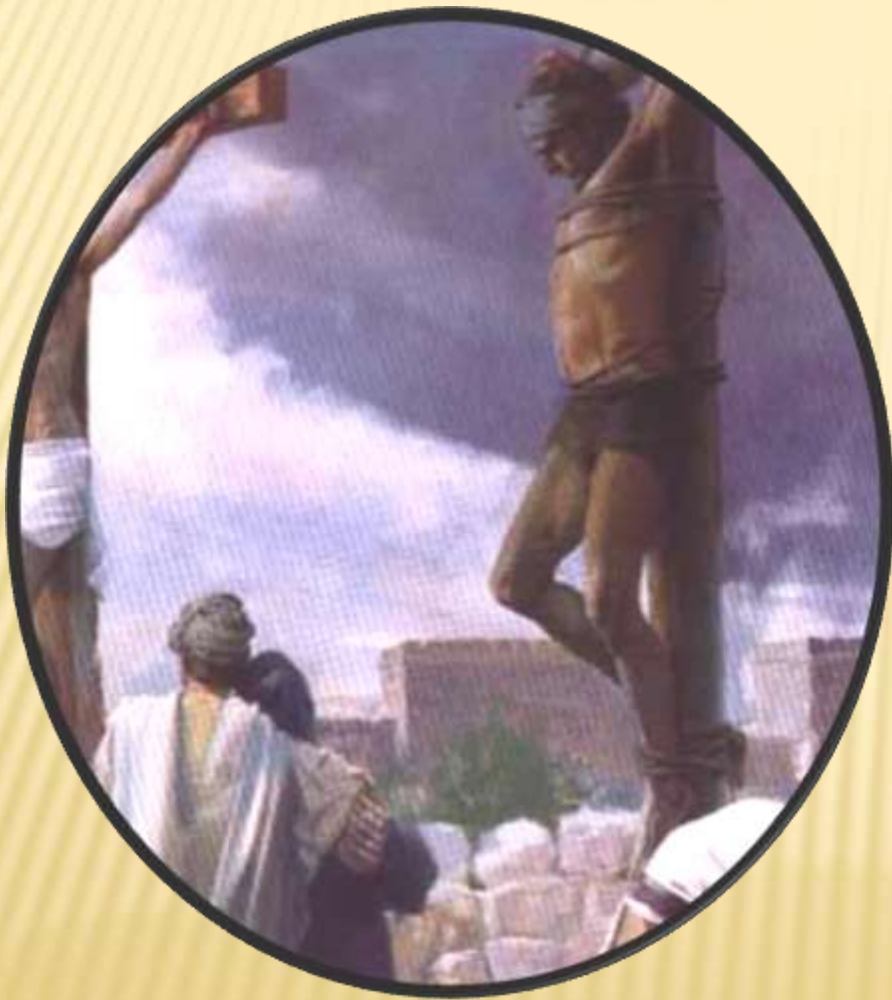

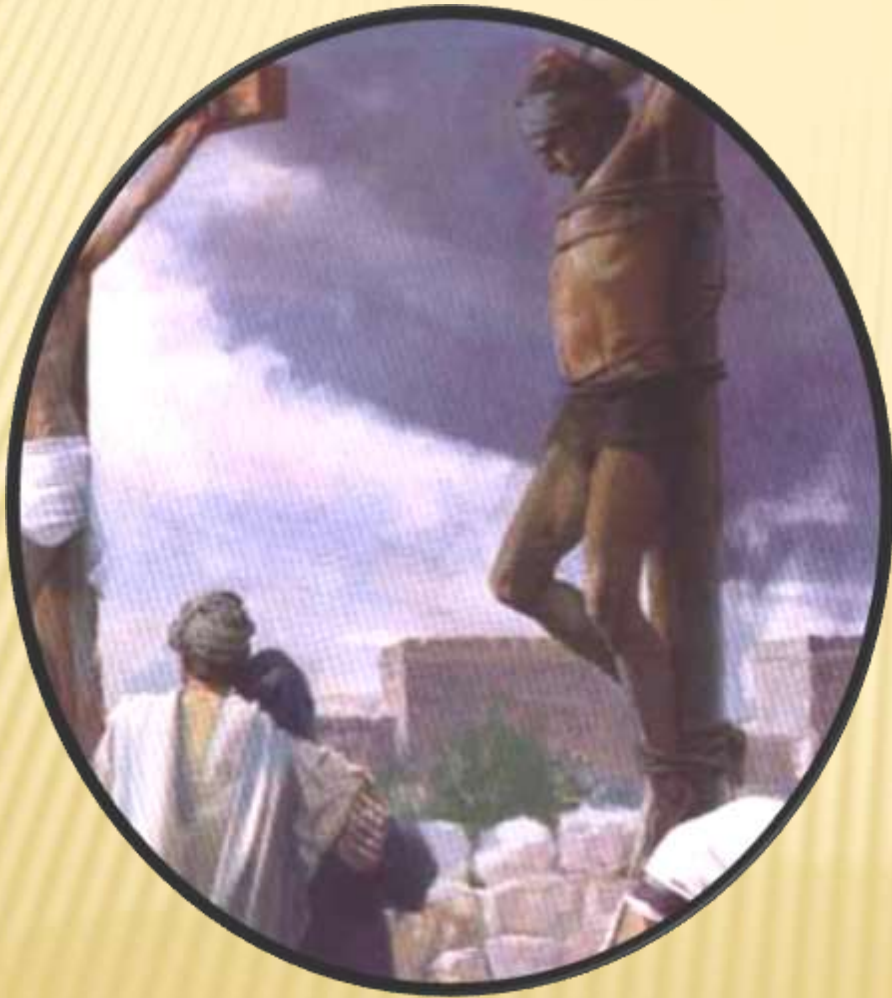

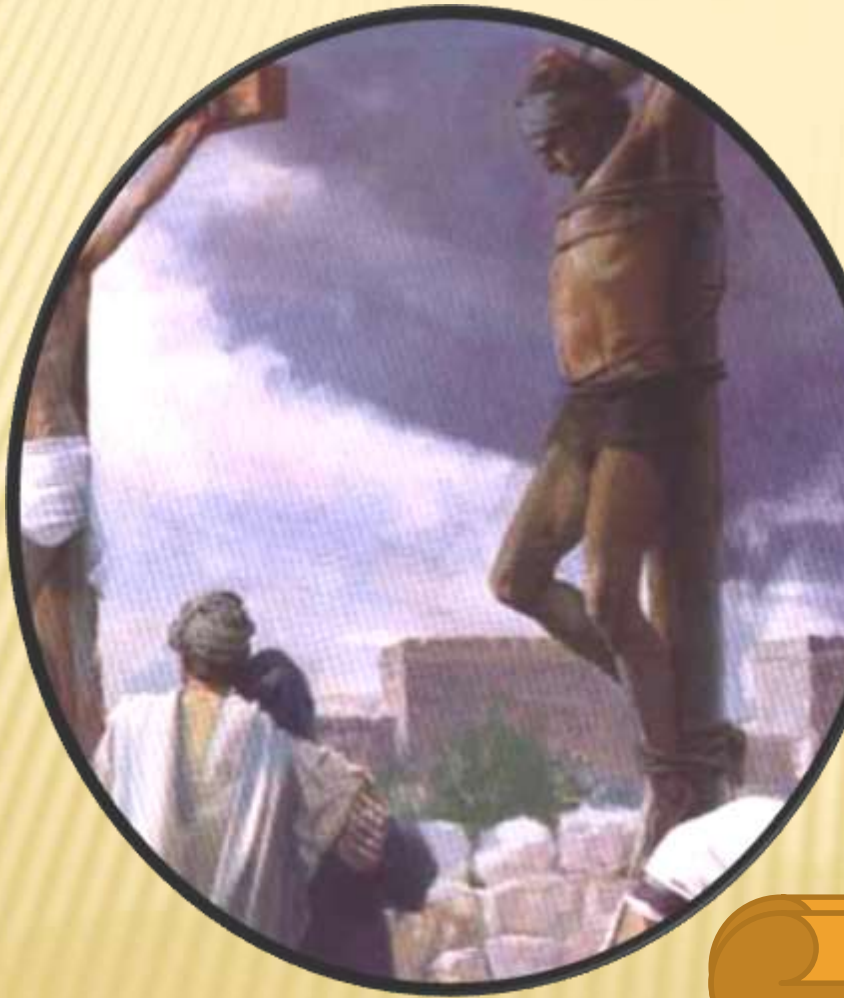

dominion over me.

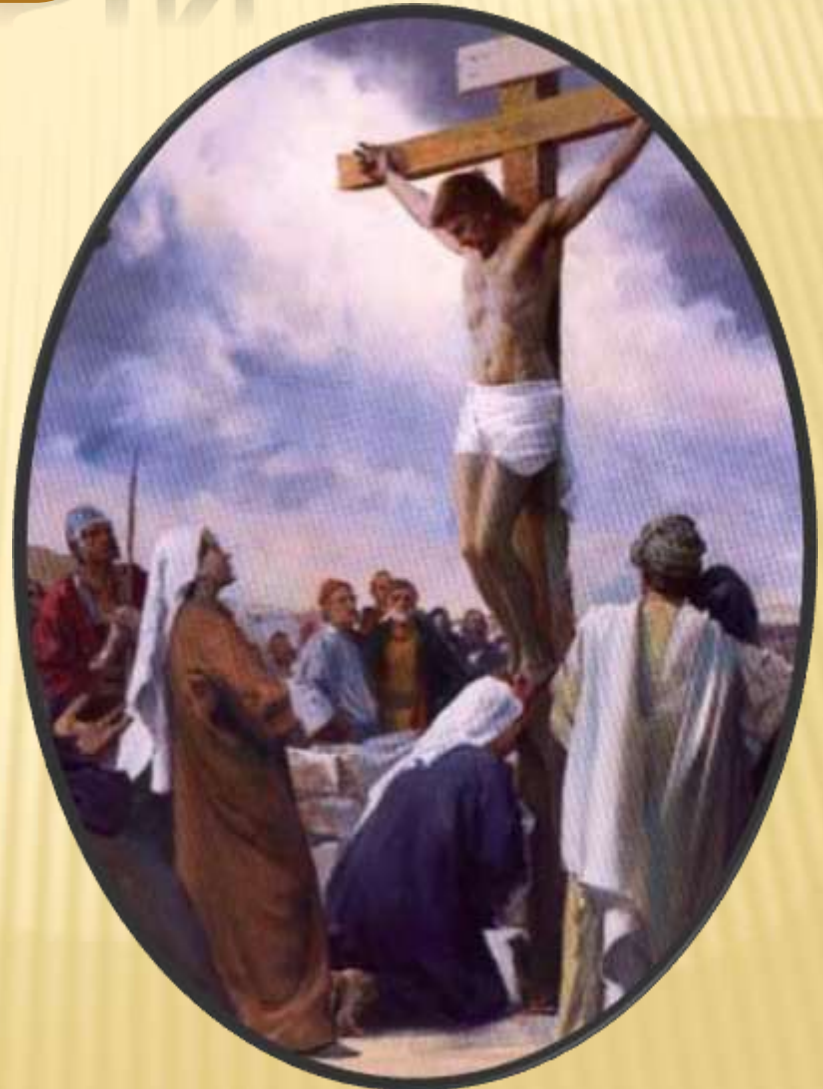
