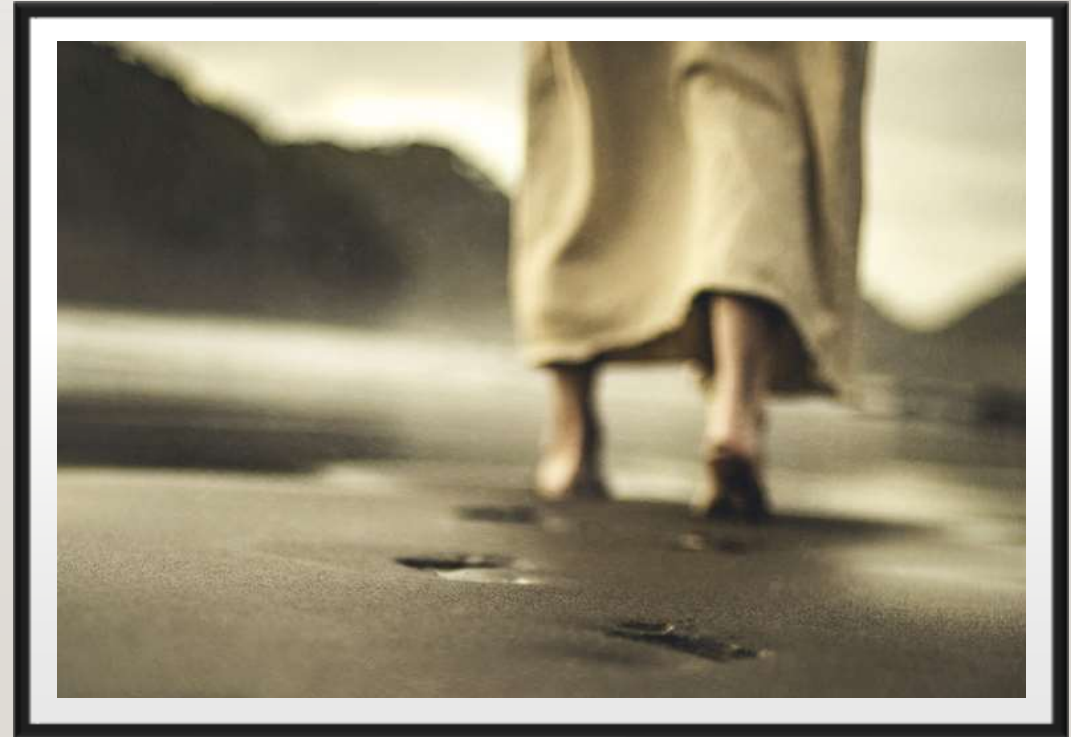
(Psalm 119:92-94 NKJV)
