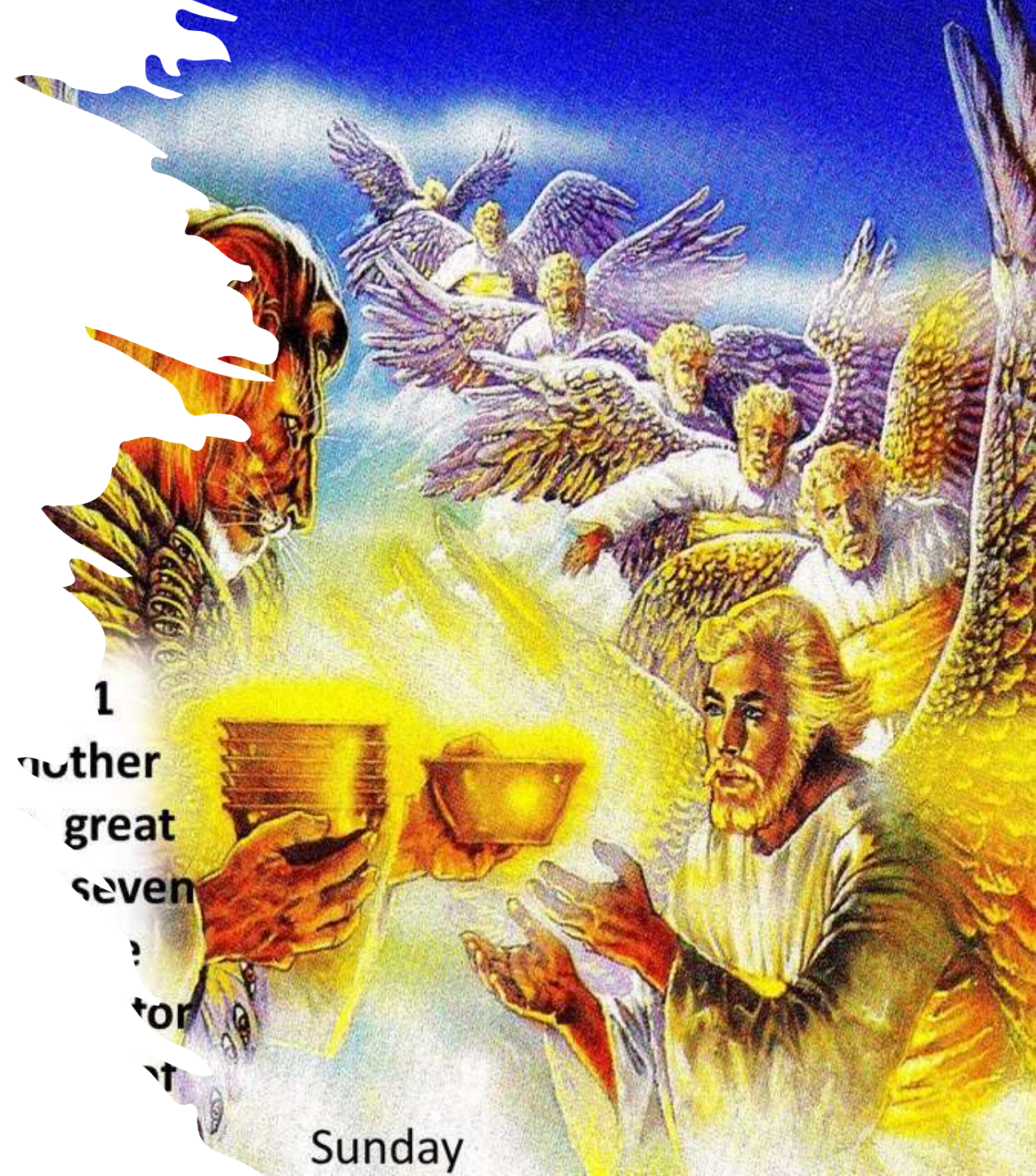
Displayed God’s saints victorious over the beasts and the declarations of three angels.

Chapter Fifteen prepares the saints for the final outpouring of His wrath against their persecutors.

Preparation for the Bowls of Wrath – vs. 1

- **Another** sign
 - *Great and Wondrous*
- Seven Angels
 - Seven **last** plagues
 - *In them the wrath of God is **complete***

The Song of Moses and the Lamb

- They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying:
- "Great and marvelous *are* Your works, Lord God Almighty!
- Just and true *are* Your ways, O King of the saints!
- Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For *You alone are* holy.
- For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."
- (Rev 15:3-4 NKJV)

(5) You should have the same attitude toward one another that Christ Jesus had,

– in heaven and on earth and under the earth –

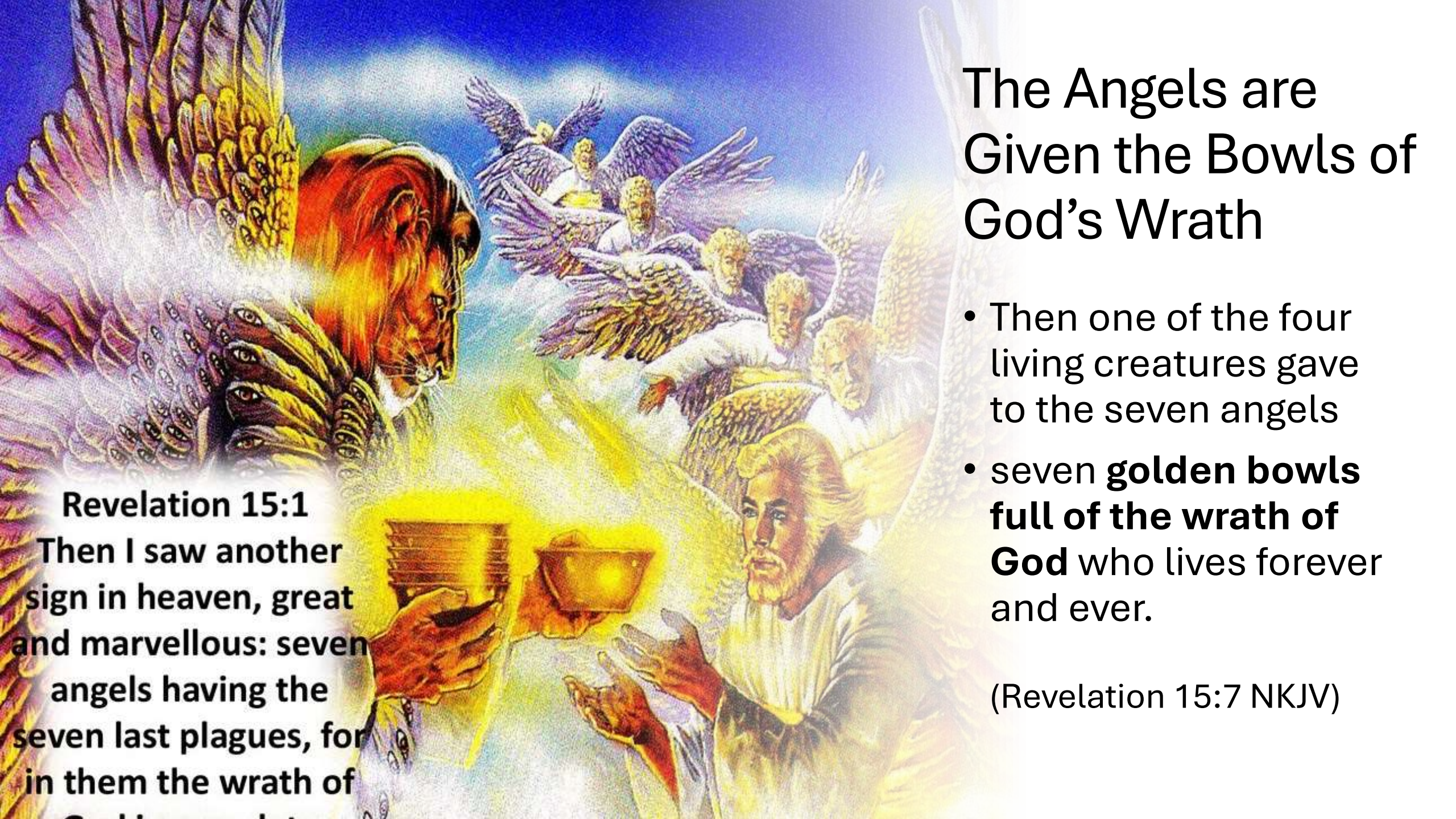
(11) and every tongue confess

After These Things... Behold

- The *temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven* was opened
- Out of the temple came the seven angels having the seven plagues
- Clothed in bright linen (represents righteousness; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10)
- Having their chests girded with golden bands (Revelation 1:13)





The Angels are Given the Bowls of God's Wrath

- Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels
- seven **golden bowls full of the wrath of God** who lives forever and ever.

(Revelation 15:7 NKJV)

The Smoke from the Glory of God

- The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power,

The Cloud of the Glory of God

- Exodus 16:10 – Appeared to Israel in the wilderness
- Exodus 24:16 – Rested on Mount Sinai six days
- Exodus 40:34-35 – Filled the Tabernacle
- Numbers 16:42 – Defended Moses and Aaron
- 1 Kings 8:11 – Filled the Temple of Solomon
- Ezekiel 10:4 – Departed the Temple before the Babylonian exile

- and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.

(Revelation 15:8 NKJV)
