# DIP, SPRINKLE, POUR

raintidzo

The priest shall **dip** his finger in the blood and **sprinkle**

baptidzo

blood seven times before the LORD, in front of the sanctuary. And the priest shall put some


of the blood on the horns of the altar of sweet incense

before the LORD, with **cheo** the tabernacle of meeting;

and he shall **pour** the remaining blood of the bull at the base of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. (Leviticus 4:6-7 NKJV)

# THE BAPTISM OF NOAH – 1 PETER 3:20-21

- THIS WAS NOT A *LITERAL* BAPTISM
- NOAH AND HIS FAMILY WERE IN THE ARK, BUT *ENCOMPASSED* BY WATER (GENESIS 7:1-7)
- THEY WERE SAVED *THROUGH* OR *BY* WATER (1 PETER 3:20)
- PETER CITES THIS AS AN ARCHETYPE OF BAPTISM WHICH **NOW SAVES US** (1 PETER 3:21)





## THE BAPTISM OF MOSES 1 CORINTHIANS 10:1-4

- ALSO, NOT A *LITERAL* BAPTISM
- MOSES AND ISRAEL CROSSED THE RED SEA, BUT WERE *ENCOMPASSED BY WATER* (EXODUS 14:22)
- PAUL WROTE, “THEY WERE ALL BAPTIZED INTO MOSES IN THE CLOUD AND IN THE SEA” (1 CORINTHIANS 10:2)
- COMPARE THIS TO “BAPTIZED INTO CHRIST” (ROMANS 6:4)

# • BAPTISM OF JOHN

## • MARK 1:1-4

- A *LITERAL* BAPTISM, REQUIRING MUCH WATER, (VS. 8; JOHN 3:23)
- TO PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD (VS. 3)
- A BAPTISM OF REPENTANCE FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS (VS. 4)
- A BAPTISM “FROM HEAVEN” OR COMMISSIONED FROM GOD. (JOHN 1:32-34; MATTHEW 21:25-26)





## JESUS' BAPTISM OF SUFFERING AND DEATH

- NOT A *LITERAL* BAPTISM
- AN "IMMERSION" IN SUFFERING AND DEATH
- IT WAS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE WILL OF GOD (MATTHEW 26:39, 42)
- THE APOSTLES WOULD SHARE IN THIS SUFFERING (MATTHEW 20:23)
- CHRISTIANS MAY ALSO PARTAKE IN THESE SUFFERINGS (1 PETER 4:13-15)

# BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT – ACTS 1:5,8

- NOT A *LITERAL* BAPTISM
- AN “IMMERSION” IN THE OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (VS. 8)
- PROMISED BY JESUS TO HIS APOSTLES (VS. 5; JOHN 14:16-18)
- RECEIVED BY THE APOSTLES ON PENTECOST (ACTS 2:1-4)
- RECEIVED BY THE FAMILY OF CORNELIUS (ACTS 10:44-45)





## BAPTISM FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS – ACTS 2:37-39

- A LITERAL BAPTISM IN WATER
- IT REQUIRED WATER (ACTS 8:36;  
10:47)
- PREREQUISITE IS FAITH (MARK 16:16;  
ACTS 8:37)
- IN THE NAME OF JESUS FOR THE  
REMISSION OF SINS (ACTS 2:38)
- AN IMMERSION IN WATER “GOING  
DOWN INTO” AND “COMING UP  
OUT OF” (ACTS 8:38-39)
- COMMANDED BY PETER (ACTS 2:38;  
ACTS 10:48)

# BAPTISM FOR THE DEAD 1 CORINTHIANS 15:29

- IS ONLY MENTIONED *HERE* IN THE SCRIPTURES
- NO INSTRUCTIONS ANYWHERE AS TO ITS PRACTICE OR PURPOSE
- REVIEW THE CONTEXT OF THE CHAPTER
- IS ALMOST CERTAINLY A REFERENCE TO THE BAPTISM FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS (CF. VS. 16; ROMANS 6:3-4)
- REFERENCED IT BECAUSE IT IS A SOURCE OF UNCERTAINTY



## WHAT IS THE “ONE BAPTISM”?

“I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace. *There is* **one** body and **one** spirit, just as you were called in **one** hope of your calling; **one** Lord, **one** faith, **one** baptism; **one** God and Father of all, Who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.”

(Ephesians 4:1-6 NKJV)

# THE “ONE” BAPTISM



- WATER BAPTISM IS THE ONLY BAPTISM IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST (ACTS 2:38)
- WATER BAPTISM IS FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS (ACTS 2:38)
- WATER BAPTISM IS THE FIRST (AND ONLY) BAPTISM TO BE **COMMANDED** (ACTS 10:48)
- WATER BAPTISM IS INTO CHRIST (ROMANS 6:3-4)
- WATER BAPTISM WASHES AWAY SIN (ACTS 22:16)
- WATER BAPTISM SAVES (1 PETER 3:21)
