




Timeline of Ezra, Nehemiah, and Esther

Haggai's Four Prophecies




Note: Technically, Haggai had five prophecies, a brief one is recorded in Haggai 1:13 from September 24, 520 B.C.


SEPTEMBER 1, 520 B.C.

- The Glory of this latter temple – 2:9




I Will Shake Heaven and Earth – Haggai 2:20-23
