**NAHUM 3:1-13** 


### The Prophet Nahum

- His name was Nahum (1c)
- He was of Elkosh (1d)
- What is Nahum (1 Cor 3:4-9)?
- He was a prophet of the LORD from the southern kingdom of Judah (1d)
- He prophesied after the fall of the northern kingdom of Israel.
- He prophesied after the fall of Thebes (3:8)
- He prophesied before the fall of the kingdom of Assyria (1a)
