

(Zephaniah 1:1 NKJV)






The 'Day of the Lord' in Zephaniah

- This is a prophetic description of a day of judgment or wrath on nations and their governments.
- In Zephaniah it refers to an imminent judgment on Jerusalem - Zephaniah 1:4
- It does not refer to the return of Jesus Christ






The Judgement on the Day of the LORD

- Judgment on the Nation of Judah (1:1-8)
 - Does Not Refer to a World-Wide Cataclysm
 - Does Not Refer to the Entire Planet
 - It is *Prophetic Hyperbole* of the "world" of the Middle East



The Judgement on the Day of the LORD

- oJudgment on the Nations
 - Judgment Against Philistia (West) 2:4-7
 - Judgement Against Moab and Ammon (East) - 2:8-11
 - Judgment on Ethiopia (South)2:12
 - Judgment on Assyria (North)2:13-15



The Judgement on the Day of the LORD

- °Judgment on Jerusalem (3:1-7)
 - ∘ Her princes 3:3a
 - ∘ Her judges 3:3b
 - ∘ Her prophets 3:4a
 - ∘ Her priests 3:4b
