


Do you believe I am lost?

- This is usually an attempt to prejudice an audience.
- This may be a sincere question.
- This may be from another faith.
- This may be from an agnostic.
- This may be from a sectarian.
- This may be from a Christian.

You Are Asking the Wrong Question!

- It does not matter what I believe.
 - My opinion is no better than anyone else's.
 - My opinion will not affect your condition.
- You need to know what the Scriptures say!
- Because *I am not your judge* (2 Corinthians 5:10).



The (Modern) Socratic Method

Elicitation

What is a square, my friend?

Undefined Answer I'm not sure.

Hypothesis

A square is a shape with four sides.

Examination

I see. And are there any other shapes with four sides? What about a door?

Response

Yes, a rectangle has four sides.

New Hypothesis

Then I suppose a square is a shape with four sides of equal length.

What Do the Scriptures Say?

- Do you believe in God? (Psalm 19:1; Romans 1:18-20; Genesis 1:1)
- Do you believe the Scriptures? (Hebrews 1:1-3; John 16:4-15; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)
- Do you believe Jesus is the Son of God? (Romans 1:1-4)
- Do you believe in heaven? (John 14:1-4)
- Do you believe in accountability? (Acts 24:25)
- Do you believe in hell? (John 5:28-29)
- What did Jesus say about condemnation? (Matthew 7:13-14; 21-23)
- What did Jesus say about salvation? (Matthew 28:18-20)



However, if one is not brought to the realization of condemnation, they will never feel the need for salvation!
