- **The Occasion – 25-29**
 - **A Certain Lawyer's Question - 25**
 - **The Lord's Answer – 26-28**
 - **The Lawyer's Attitude - 29**
- **The Parable – 30-37**
 - **A Certain Man - 30**
 - **Travel Was Slow, Treacherous**
 - **His Sorry State: Robbed, Beaten, Left for Dead**



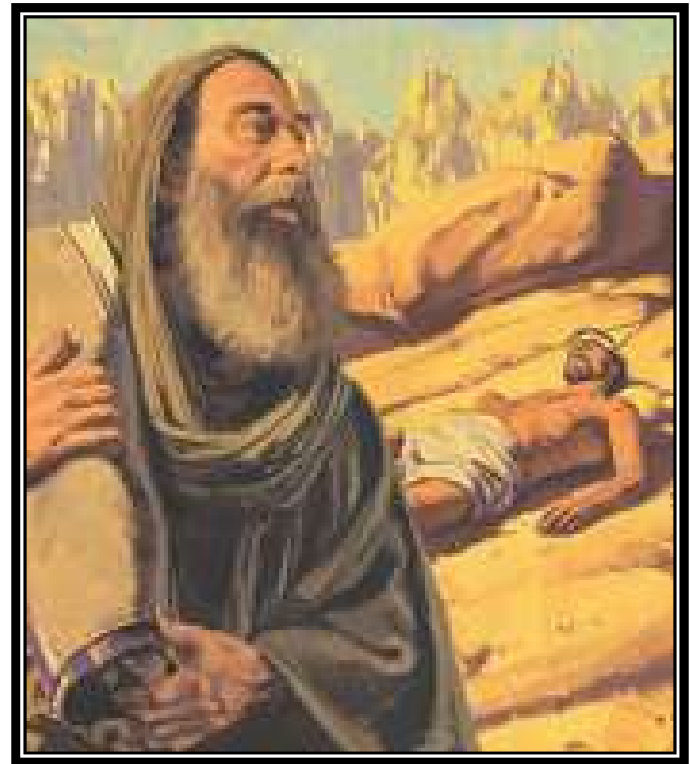
The Robber's Rule



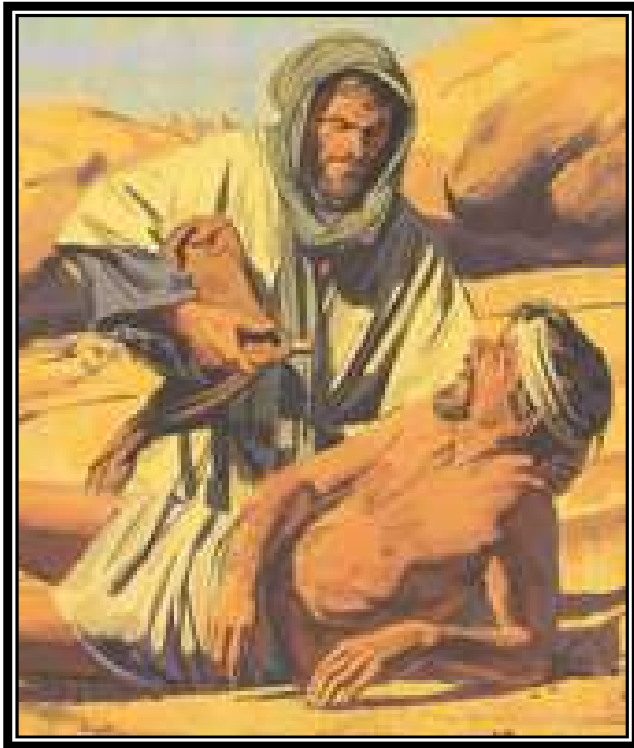
- **The Iron Rule**
- **“What’s Yours is Mine, If I Can Take it.”**
- **“Do Unto Others *Before They Do It To You*”**
- **This is Forbidden – Romans 13:9**

The Priest and Levite's Rule

- **The Bronze Rule**
- “What’s Mine is Mine, and I’m Going to Keep It.”
- “Do Unto Others *As They Have Done* to You.”
- This is Also Forbidden by the “Royal Law” – James 2:8



The Samaritan's Rule



- **The Golden Rule**
- **“What’s Mine Is Yours If You Need It.”**
- **“Do Unto Others *As You Would Have Them Do To You.*”**
